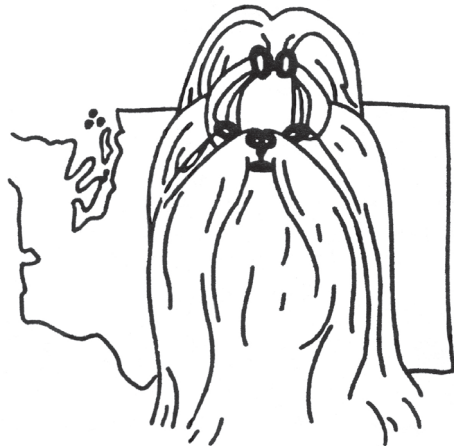

#### DIRECTIONS TO AFTER-HOURS VET FROM KING COUNTY FAIR

**GROUND:** Start on 284th Ave SE (North). Turn LEFT (West) onto SR-410 [Roosevelt Ave E]. Bear RIGHT (Northwest) onto SR-164 [Griffin Ave]. Road name changes to Auburn Way S, then changes to Auburn Way N. Stay on Auburn Way N. to 718 Auburn Way N (east side of road). Total: 16.6 miles.

#### ROUTES TO THE SHOW

**FROM THE NORTH OR SOUTH ON I-5** - Take the Auburn Exit (Highway 18). Go to Auburn and take the Enumclaw Exit to Highway 164. Follow the signs to Enumclaw (Highway 410), just before Enumclaw, turn right on 244th, go to 456th and turn left. It becomes Warner. Stay on Warner to the fairgrounds.

**GOING SOUTH ON I-405 OR COMING FROM THE RENTON AREA** - Go east on Maple Valley Highway (Highway 169), go through Black Diamond, continue on until 416th SE, turn left, then follow signs to the fairgrounds.

#### TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

**NOTE:** BECAUSE OF TRAVEL TIME TO THE SHOW SITE, TRANSFER OF ENTRIES AND REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS FOR PUBLISHED JUDGE CHANGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON THURSDAY, OCTOBER 5. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.

**CONFORMATION:** Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

**RV PARKING**

RV parking is available in the North Lot for \$30 per night reserved. \$35 day of show. No hookups and RV must be self-contained. This is on first-come, first-served basis. Absolutely no discharging of waste of any kind will be permitted. Rigs over 40 ft. total length (including tow vehicle) must be in the North Lot.

RV parking with full hook-up is available at the Expo Center through King County Parks. Please note that this area is quite some distance from the rings. TDCOPS is not responsible for this area. To make a reservation please call 360-615-5624. You will need to pay with a credit card. Payment can be made on arrival on a first come, first served basis.

**ADDITIONAL SHOW/GROUNDS RULES**

We would like to return here every year in the future so we are asking everyone to please act responsibly and to follow a few simple rules. Anyone caught violating any of these rules could be subject to an AKC bench show hearing or a sanction from the club.

- One exercise pen allowed per grooming space in the building.
- Smoking permitted in designated areas only.
- There will be no space for unentered dogs in the Show Ring and Crating areas. Exhibitors and handlers are required to keep their grooming and parking areas clean both during and after the show. Please set a good example of responsible dog ownership to our spectators and help us retain this site for future events.
- Parents are expected to supervise their children at all times.
- Each exhibitor is responsible to pick up after his/her own dog(s).
- The Show Chairman or any club member will have the authority to maintain order on the show site, grooming area and parking lot.
- All club members will be policing the grounds and anyone found violating the rules will be reported to the Show Chairman. Violators are subject to a bench hearing.

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – ALL EVENTS**

- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 11, Section 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent/Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- ALL RIGHTS TO TELEVISION, VIDEOTAPE, ADVERTISE, PHOTOGRAPH, PROMOTE or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. All persons and animals on the Show Grounds at any time while the show is in progress, do by attending this show or participating therein, grant to the Club the right to photograph, televise, videotape, audiotape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent.
