Best Veteran/Bred by Exhibitor/Puppy will be awarded from the First Place winners in the Veteran/Bred by Exhibitor/Puppy classes immediately following each breed on their respective day. If the Best of Breed is awarded to a dog/bitch coming from a Veteran/Bred by Exhibitor/Puppy Class for that breed on that day, the Best Veteran/Bred by Exhibitor/Puppy win is automatic. Best Veteran/Bred by Exhibitor/Puppy Group judging will take place preceding Regular Group judging. First through Fourth Place will be awarded. Judge is the same as regular breed/group judge.

GROUND RULES

EXHIBITORS & HANDLERS will be held responsible for all conditions in and around their crates and setup areas.

AN EXERCISE AREA will be provided. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to take care of their dogs and to clean any area soiled by their dogs

GENERAL GROOMING set-up will be open starting at Noon on Thursday, May 31, 2018. Grooming may be opened earlier once the show setup is completed. There will be NO GROOMING set-up allowed before the show set-up is completed. PLEASE do not interfere with Shetland Sheepdog specialties. ALL GENERATORS will only be allowed only at fence line setups or behind the fence in your setup. Electricity & shelters are not available at this show site so you will need to make your own arrangements for the use of a generator & easy-up shelter. Due to SAFETY, there will be NO extension cords for generators run past those setups along the fence line.

NO DOGS ALLOWED in children’s playgrounds on CBA location. This risks the clubs ability to continue holding their shows on this site and the Event Committee will hold hearing(s) if anyone has not complied that is entered. Signs will be posted for everyone’s attention for all dogs entered for the AHGC. The welfare of an Exhibitor’s children and dog(s) is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children and dog(s) OR THEY WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOW PREMISES. (This includes disturbances as well).

No smoking allowed inside the fenced area – Smoking will be outside the fenced area

IF IT IS NECESSARY TO RESCUE A DOG from a parked car on the show grounds, the Club will not be responsible or liable for any damages to the car involved.

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES or Non-Prescription Drug use allowed.

USE OF RAMPS – HERDING BREEDS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group judging: Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphund, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, and Spanish Water Dogs.

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. (02/2018)

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – ALL EVENTS

- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Show Secretary is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the club is required to refund the entry fee. The club may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 11, Section 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- ALL RIGHTS TO TELEVISION, VIDEOTAPE, ADVERTISE, PHOTOGRAPH, PROMOTE or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. All persons and animals on the Show Grounds at any time while the show is in progress, do by attending this show or participating therein, grant to the Club the right to photograph, televise, videotape, audiotape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent. The Club is not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at this show.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES – FRIDAY ONLY

The purpose of the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner-Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.



- Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition (Group). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group competition.

- *Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit.

- The Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non-regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.

**Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household. Household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household.*

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON TUESDAY, MAY 29. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SHOW SECRETARY ON SITE.

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another. provided this transfer must be made to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship class at the show.

OBEDIENCE OR RALLY: A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class; or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner’s records the handler and dog are eligible provided the club offers transfers. Transfers from an “A” to “B” class at the same level are allowed provided the host club allows transfers. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Clubs may choose to accept transfers prior to the day of the trial and this should be clearly stated in the premium list. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit.
