Ads MUST be built in proportion to a catalog page. Image area is 4.5"x7.25", including any border. Be aware, if you build your ad 8.5x11, it will be shrunk to fit a catalog page, and will not be in proportion to the page.

It is recommended that you burn a CD of any of your electronic ads and submit that to the ad chairman for your specialty. CD should be readable in both PC and MAC format. This is much more stable than email.

**BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**

**AWARD OF MERIT:** At the judge's sole discretion, Awards of Merit may be awarded in recognition of those entrants in the Best of Breed competition who are in serious consideration for the top award, as follows: 1 AOM if 9 or fewer champions are entered; 2 AOMs if 10 or more champions are entered. Whether any Award(s) of Merit are awarded is entirely up to the judge. Recipient(s) will receive a dark green rosette.

**Non-Regular Classes (Involving multiple dog entries)**

**STUD DOG CLASS:** For Stud Dogs and two of their get. For complete Stud Dog regulations, see Page 8.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS:** For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. For complete Brood Bitch regulations, see Page 8.

**BRACE CLASS:** Two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. For complete Brace regulations, see Page 8.

**PARADE OF VETERANS**

This class is non-competitive and is for dogs and bitches 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. The entry fee is \$12. Veterans entered in this class MAY NOT compete in any Regular or Non-Regular class at this show other than in Veteran Sweepstakes. Each entrant will receive a rosette with the entrant's name inscribed. Entrants need not be champions or other titleholders. Owners are to bring a written biography for their dog to the show, which will be read while the dog is in the ring.

**SWEEPSTAKES**

Sweepstakes is open to all Afghan Hounds who, on the day of the show, will be six months old, but under eighteen months. Entrant must be entered in one of the Regular Classes, with Sweepstakes marked in the "Additional Classes" box of the Entry Form.

**NOVICE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

The winner of a Novice Class shall automatically become eligible upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the third (3rd) first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in the Open Class.

**CLASS DESCRIPTIONS –BOTH SPECIALTIES**

**BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**

**The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owners' records.**

**Non-Regular Classes (Involving multiple dog entries)**

**STUD DOG CLASS:** Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS:** Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class. *NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.*

**BRACE CLASS:** Two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The Dogs comprising a Brace **MUST** be named at the time of entry. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars **MUST** be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by same owner, dogs comprising **EACH BRACE** must be designated "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc.



## NOTICES FOR ALL EXHIBITORS



### – NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – ALL EVENTS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The AKC will collect a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on each entry of a dog, and 50 cent Recording Fee for the first entry of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule. Ch.11, Sec. 2). In accordance with AKC Rally regulations, the AKC will collect a \$3.00 per entry of dog Rally Event Service Fee. A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for AKC.
- **CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS**
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**. The Club and/or its Superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. **RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.**
- **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE.** The Superintendent will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY BASIS**.
- **REFUNDS** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent **AFTER THE SHOW**. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- **FAX ENTRIES** – Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per show. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge of \$20.00 will be added. **FAX NUMBER: (360) 683-6654.** This is for Fax Machine **ONLY**. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Ch. 11, Sec. 4). - **ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED** after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor **NOT** receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, **PLEASE** notify the Superintendent at (360) 683-1507 or email [dogshows@barayevents.com](mailto:dogshows@barayevents.com).
- Entry fees shall **NOT** be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for **DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS**. The Superintendent will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show **NO REFUND** will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- **LOSS OR DAMAGE** – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- **TROPHIES & PRIZES** will be awarded in the ring to the person exhibiting the dog. No awards will be mailed.
- **ALL RIGHTS TO TELEVISION, VIDEOTAPE, ADVERTISE, PHOTOGRAPH, PROMOTE** or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. Turn Right onto 212th Way SE (right after green bridge sitting on land at right). Take first Left into Argus Ranch and follow drive straight ahead to Arena and signed parking.

**FROM SR-169 NORTHBOUND:** Turn Left onto SE Green Valley Rd. (in front of the Boondocks Nursery). Go approx. 4 miles. Turn Left onto 212th Way SE. Go over the cement bridge (Whitney Bridge). Take first left into Argus Ranch and follow drive straight ahead to Arena and signed parking.

**FROM SR-169 SOUTHBOUND:** Turn Right onto Roberts Dr. (in front of the coal car). Go approx. 4 miles. Turn Left onto 218th St. At bottom of the hill is a stop sign. Go straight across over cement bridge (Whitney Bridge). Take first Left into Argus Ranch and follow drive straight ahead to Arena and signed parking.

### EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

**Animals left in vehicles will be monitored by County Control Officers and Club Members. If animals are in distress due to heat or any other circumstance, the vehicle will be forcibly entered, the animal recovered and the owner cited.**

### PLEASE NOTE THERE WILL BE NO ELECTRICITY AVAILABLE AT THESE SHOWS.

With the exception of paid overnight parking spaces, there will be no electricity available at these shows. To accommodate exhibitors who wish to use their own portable power generators for grooming, there will be a first come, first served grooming area designated for this purpose (generators may not be used outside of the designated grooming area). This grooming area will be within walking distance of the rings, but will not be directly on the field where the show rings and main grooming areas are located in respect of fellow exhibitors. Please help protect the future use of our beautiful show grounds. Bring your own shade.
